- We have a 7-member Council consisting of President Judy Wagner, Vice President Carol Smith, Secretary Deb Thomas, and members, Sandy Baer, Wendy Fincham, Larry Lee, and Joey Russo. Greg Price is our Treasurer.
- David Brown has completed his fourth year as our Pastor. He is also the Treasurer of the Living Water Association, and serves on the Heartland Conference Board.
- Our Trinity in the Community (T'nC) local mission program continued to provide clothing and utility assistance to area residents in need.
- Our Empowering Scholars Program (ESP) provides children's clothing. ESP helps fund school programs.
- We assembled food boxes for familits at Findley CLC, and provided Christmas Gifts for 20 children.
- We host Scouts, and daily 12-step Recovery meetings. The Serenity Singers rehearse in our Choir Room. The Akron Aviators and a Cheerleading group have used our gym. The Glorious Gospel Church (Nepalese) and Congolese Christian Church use our building on Sunday afternoons.
- Trinity's women gather at restaurants on the second Tuesday of each month for Ladies' Night Out a time of food and fellowship.
- The Men's Ministry meets on Thursday mornings and works on projects around our church building.
- Major projects this year included grounds clean-up, cleaning inside the building, plumbing and electrical repairs. We have contracted for painting and slate roof repairs.
- Our church received recognition for more than 100 years of service to the North Hill community.


